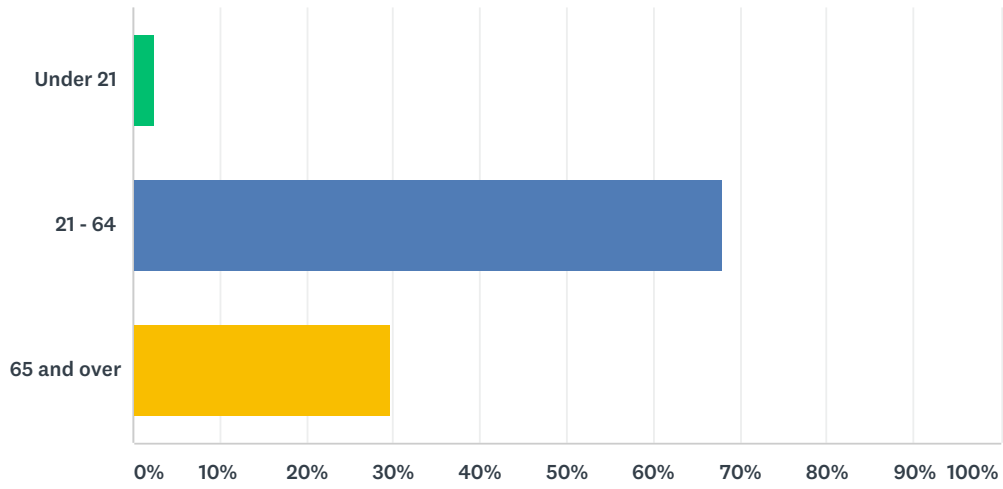


## Q1 What age range do you fall into?

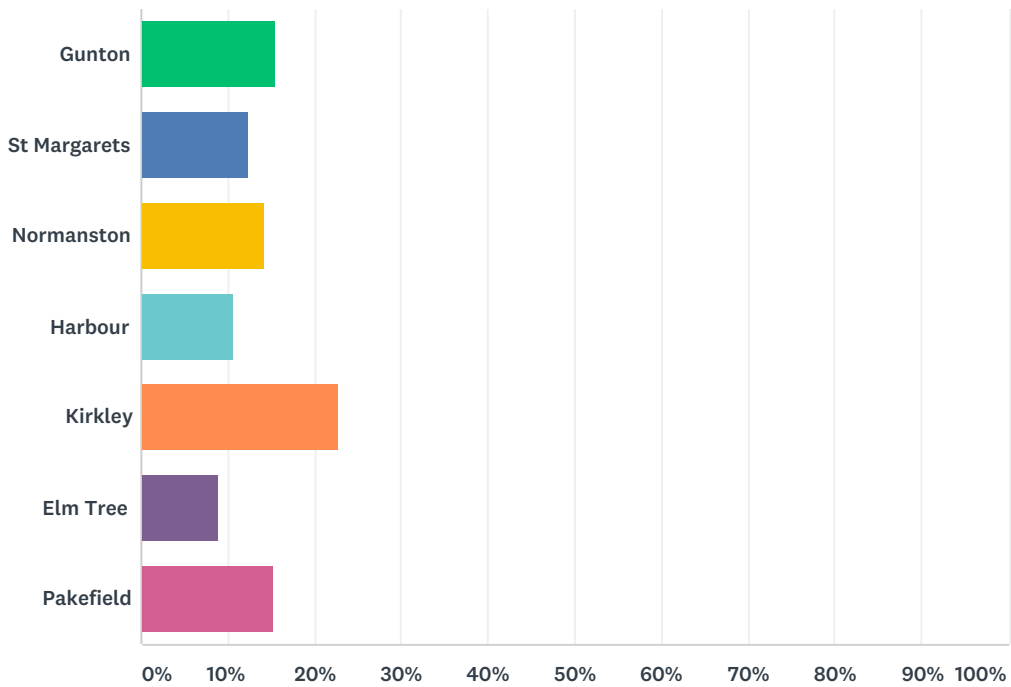

## Q2 Which area of the Town do you live in? (A map of the wards can be found here)

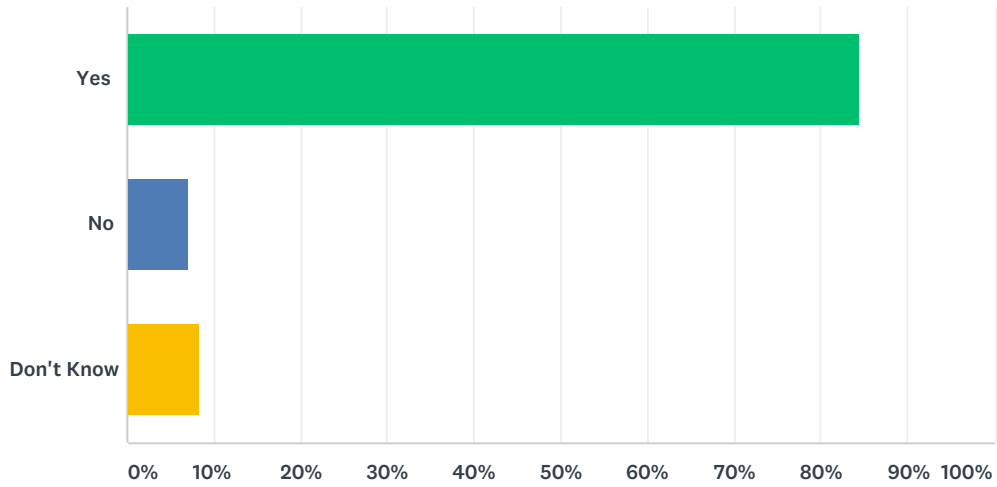

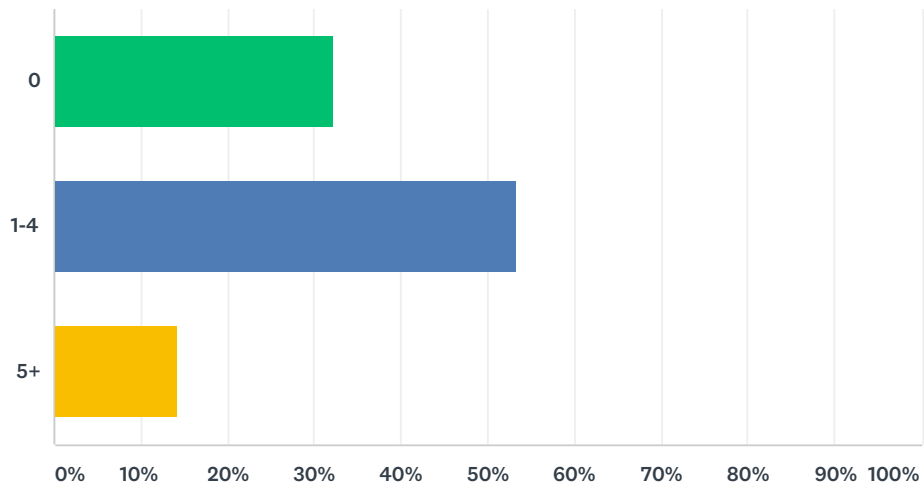

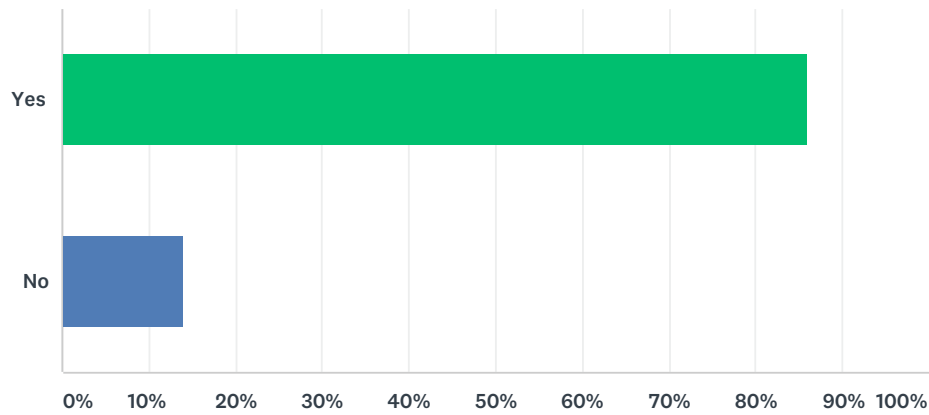

## Q6 Are you in favour of Lowestoft Town Council continuing to offer financial support to the Marina Theatre?

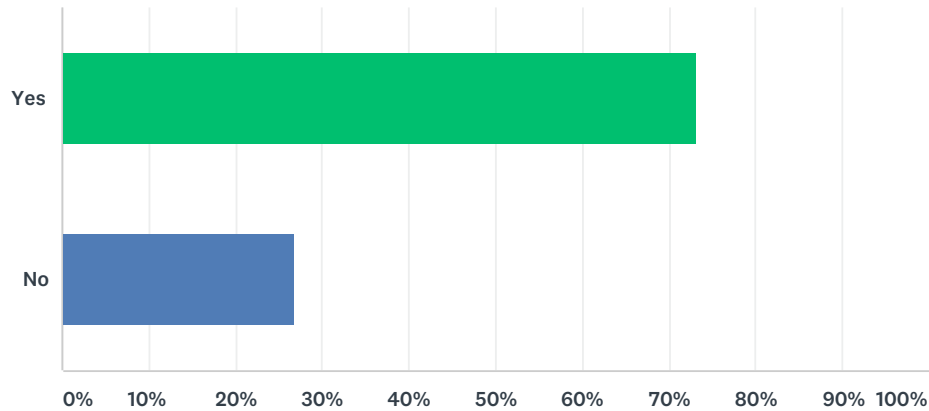

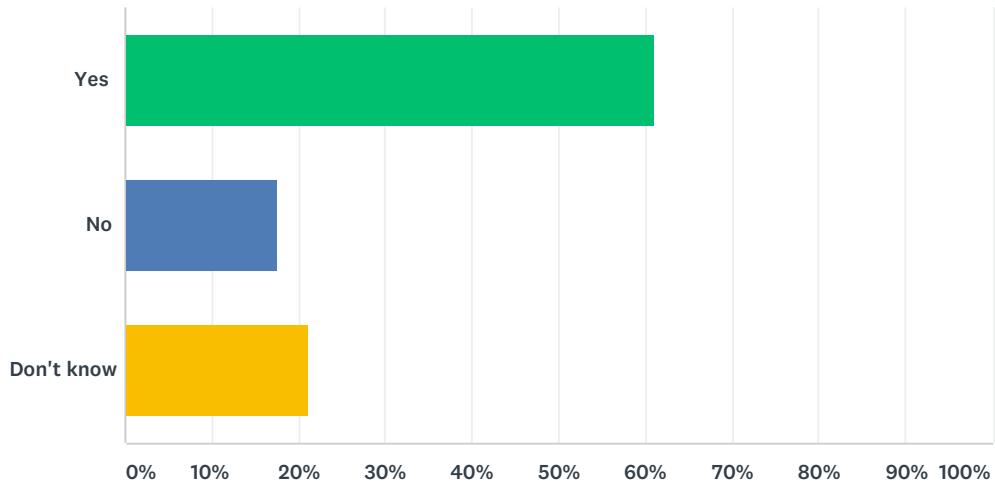

## Q11 Do you value the provision of these facilities?

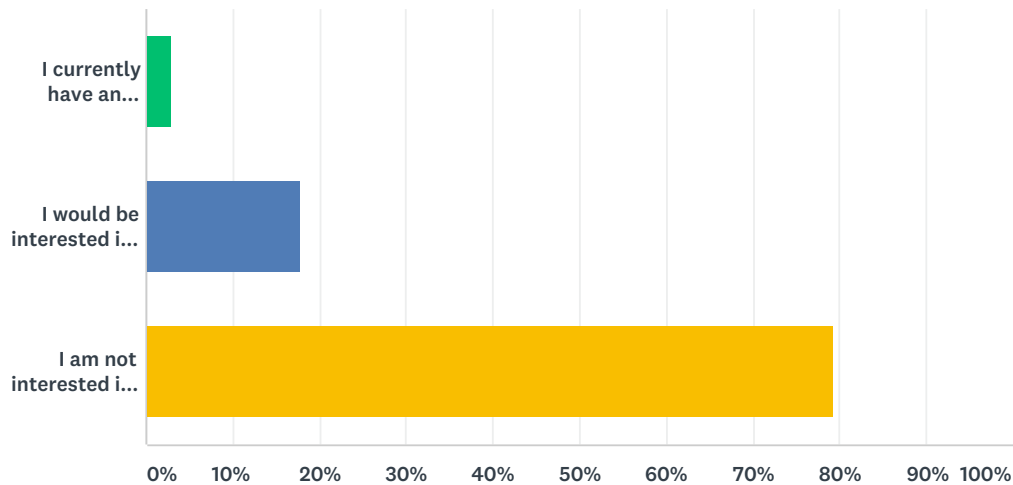

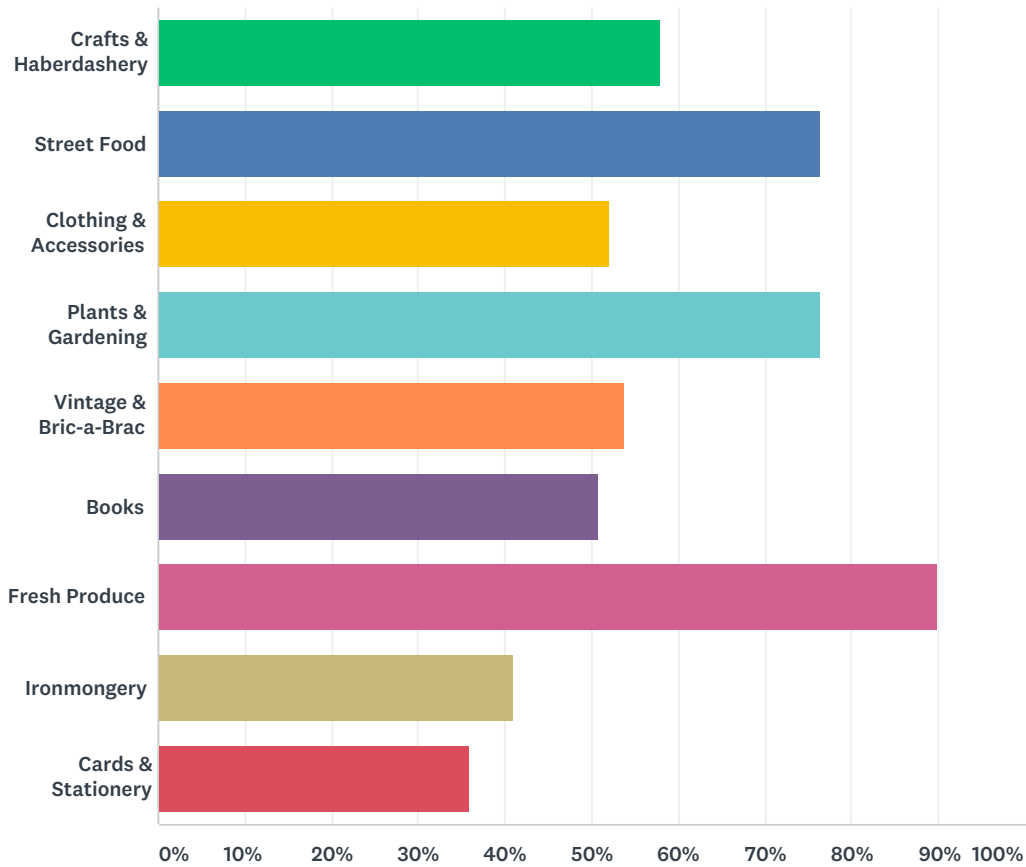

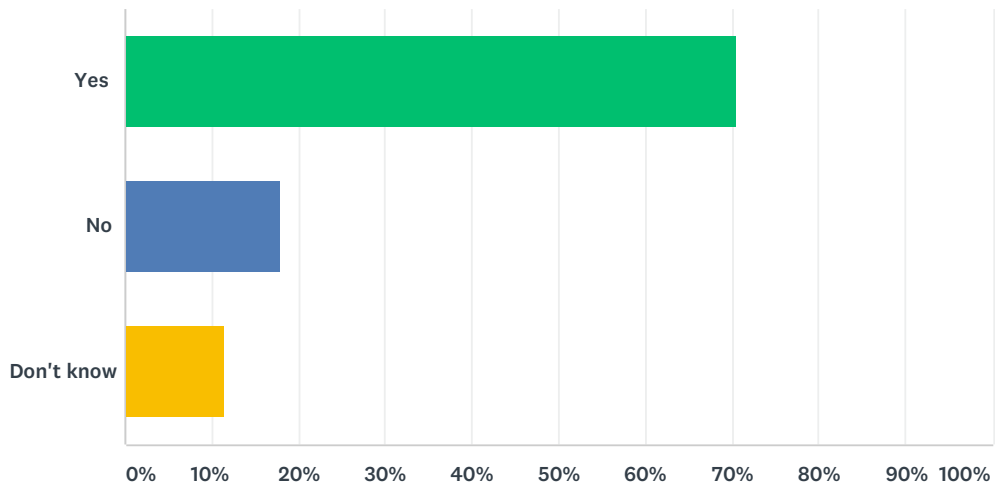

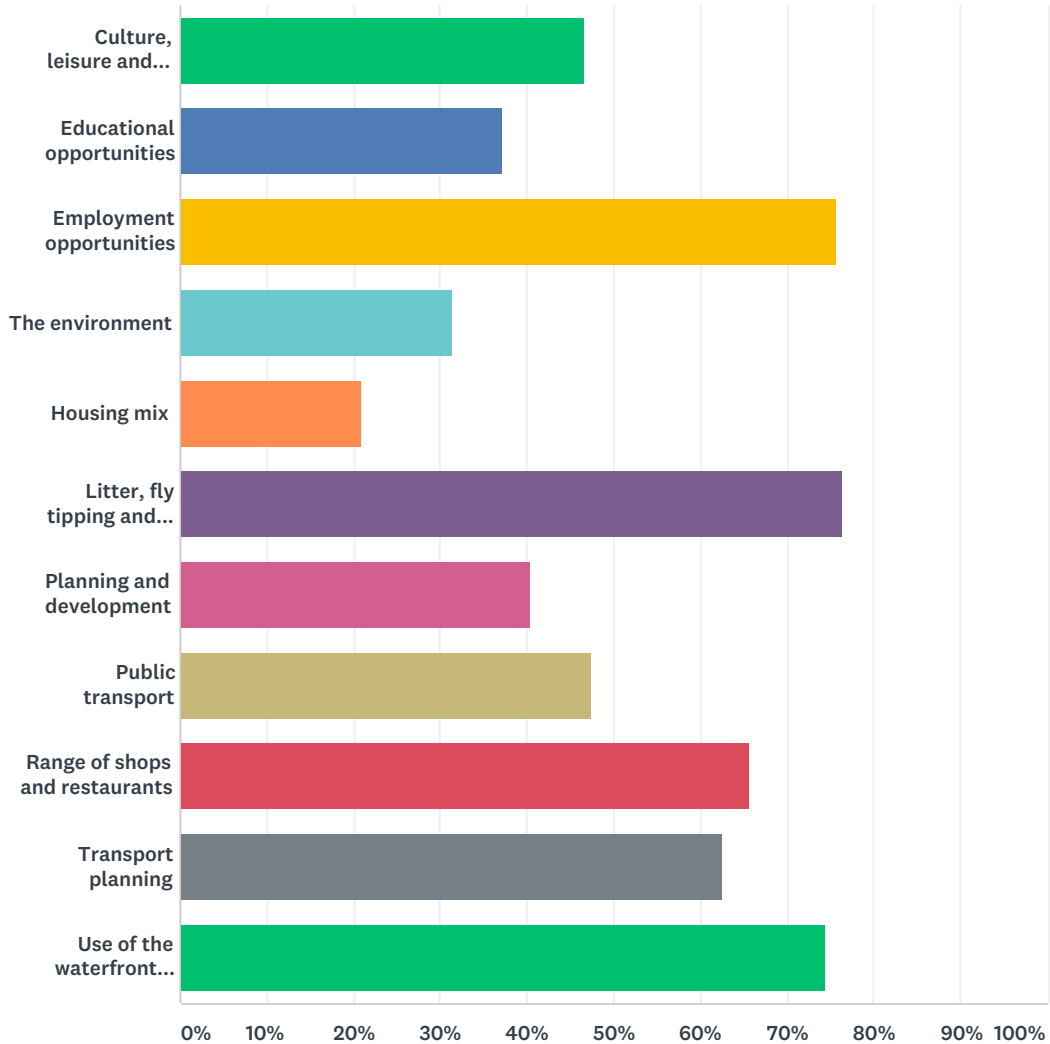
