Spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus	Attendees at organised performances	<p>The walking panto production has been designed specifically to achieve maximum social distancing.</p> <p>The “audience” will arrive one household at a time with 10 minutes between each household. They will observe the element of the story being performed at the park and then they will leave to go to the next site. At no time will they come into contact with other groups.</p> <p>The production will utilise marshalls to ensure that the gaps between groups are not compromised and that other people do not tag onto any group.</p> <p>The event is outdoors where transmission of the virus is hardest. In addition any regulations in force at the time of the performance will be adhere to.</p>	<p>All attendees will be asked to not attend if they have any covid symptoms.</p> <p>Staff and volunteers will be empowered to challenge anyone appearing to have covid symptoms.</p>	DR	4/5/6 Dec

Tech Crew	Spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus	<p>Minimal possible Tech crew will be used.</p> <p>Where Seagull volunteers or staff are used, they will maintain social distance from the performers and audience wherever possible.</p>		DR	10/11/20
