

Please can you ensure that the following is included and addressed at the forthcoming meeting of the Assets, Inclusion and Development Committee due to be held in early August

The residents of the part of Harris Ave are unhappy with the way you have dealt with our concerns over the siting of a new bus stop and shelter at the Hollingsworth road end of Harris Ave,

May we remind you that the residents of the area consist of elderly some of whom live alone and families with very young children.

A lot of us have lived in the same houses for 30 -40 yers plus so have a better understanding of the street than you councillors that do not live on it.

You are determined to push this trough even though we have voiced our concerns over an increase in antisocial behaviour that we are convinced will happen as a result of this shelter being erected and you have washed your hands of this

You were all asked if any of you would be happy to have this bus shelter erected near your property, none of you chose to answer that question. If however any of you feel that you would be happy, please raise a motion to have it re-located, the residents Harris Ave will support you in this but we doubt that your fellow residents will.

We have constantly reminded you of the anti-social behaviour when the previous bus stop was there, as well as the nearby bench and telephone kiosk, all of which have been removed due to anti-social behaviour and vandalism.

You say that we cannot look to past behaviour, (which we have documented to yourself's on numerous occasions) to how the future will pan out. We however disagree, if nobody looked to the past, then ships would still be built like the Titanic and Ferry companies would sail still using the practices that sank the Herald of Free Enterprise.

You have dodged all of our questions without giving clear answers, therefore we would like to to answer the following

- 1) You state the planning permission is not required for this shelter as there was one there before. However, this is a different shelter in a different position, so please can you specifically under what clauses in council and planning regulations that exerts this re-located bust stop and new shelter from planning regulations.
- 2) Please detail any risk assessment that you have carried out and control measures you will put in place that deals with Anti-social behaviour
- 3) Please disclose the impact Assessment that you have carried out in relation to the residents that live in the vicinity of this Bus Shelter
- 4) Please disclose the data that you have used to determine the this is the best stop on the route for this shelter.
- 5) Please state what the council will do should there be an increase in anti-social behaviour and vandalism. We will hold the council responsible for it and as the cause of it, in this, the council has a duty of care to redress the problems.
