

Project Apocalypse Constitution

Article I: Name and Purpose

Section 1: Name

The name of this organization shall be Project Apocalypse, hereinafter referred to as the "Group."

Section 2: Purpose

The purpose of the Group is to provide a platform for live-action role-playing, fostering creativity, teamwork, and immersive storytelling experiences for its participants.

Article II: Membership

Section 1: Eligibility

Membership is open to all individuals who express an interest in participating in live-action role-playing events, without discrimination based on age, gender, race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, disability, religion, or socio-economic status.

Section 2: Rights and Responsibilities

All members have the right to participate in Group events and activities. Members are responsible for adhering to the Group's rules, policies, and codes of conduct.

Article III: Governance Structure

Section 1: Organizers

The Group shall be organized and managed by a team of organizers. The number of organizers, their roles, and responsibilities shall be determined by mutual agreement among the organizers.

Section 2: Decision-Making

Major decisions, including rule changes, event planning, and financial matters, shall be made collectively by the organizers. In the event of a disagreement, a simple majority vote will prevail.

Article IV: Events and Storytelling

Section 1: Event Planning

Organizers are responsible for planning and executing Group events, including securing venues, developing storylines, and ensuring participant safety.

Section 2: Character Creation and Development

Participants have the freedom to create and develop their characters within the established rules and guidelines. Organizers may provide overarching story arcs and challenges.

Article V: Code of Conduct

Section 1: In-Game Behavior

Participants must adhere to a code of conduct governing in-game behavior. This includes respecting the storyline, other participants, and the game environment.

Section 2: Out-of-Game Behavior

Participants are expected to conduct themselves with respect and consideration for others both during and outside of Group events. Discrimination, harassment, and disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.

Article VI: Amendments

This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of the organizers. Proposed amendments must be circulated among organizers at least [insert time frame] before a vote.

Article VII: Dissolution

In the event of the Group's dissolution, any remaining assets shall be donated to a charitable organization or cause related to the interests of the Group, as determined by the organizers.
